



Advertisement for Math Interventionist

Virtus Academy of SC, a public charter school located in Florence, SC, seeks an individual with experience in working with school-age children to join the team of a fast-growing school of Kindergarten through 8th-grade students with an approximate enrollment of 600 students in 2021/22. Virtus Academy will grow to serve Grades K - 12 adding one grade per year. The school moved into a new 60,000 plus square foot facility in August 2020. The school is sponsored by The Charter Institute at Erskine.

The Math Interventionist is responsible for supporting student achievement in the area of Mathematics with special attention to Tier II and III instruction. The Interventionist provides individual or small group instruction to students who are struggling academically. This position is also responsible for monitoring, reporting, and communicating student progress and performance to the teachers and administration.

Requires high school diploma or GED. Applicants must also meet ONE of the requirements below:

1. At least two years of study (60 semester hours) at an accredited institution of higher education; or
2. An associate's degree (or higher); or
3. A minimum passing score of 456 on the [ParaPro Assessment](#) (ETS.org).
Assessment must be taken within 30 days of hire, and successfully completed within 90 days of hire.

Applicants should have experience working with young children in the classroom or in a child care setting, or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities. Must possess a valid state driver's license.

Compensation for the successful candidate will be based on education and experience. Compensation will include a benefits package with SC PEBA health insurance, a private employer match retirement plan, professional development, etc.
